

If you suspect developmental delays with your child, fill out 'Get Help, Get Started' on this web site, or give us a call at (800) 418-9319. The sooner a child is diagnosed and receives treatment, the better the results are over the long term.

We will contact you to ask questions about your child's condition and to see if our services are most suitable to treat their behavior problem. If your child has not received a diagnosis, then we will refer you to a medical professional to make one.

If your child has a diagnosis that is treated with behavior services, call us and we will schedule one of our Behavior Analysts to visit your home for an initial assessment. We want to be thorough in our analysis so this assessment, called a Functional Behavior Assessment, can take up to 36 clinical hours to complete.

Your Behavior Analyst will discuss their assessment of your child's skill levels, and will recommend a treatment plan for you.

We will prepare a contract showing your preference for private pay and a payment plan.

In order to best understand your child's treatment program, you'll attend a Group Parent Education Class. This training class will provide instruction on practical applications that will be used in your child's treatment program (i.e. teaching new skills and reducing problem behaviors). This class takes a total of 16 hours to complete.
